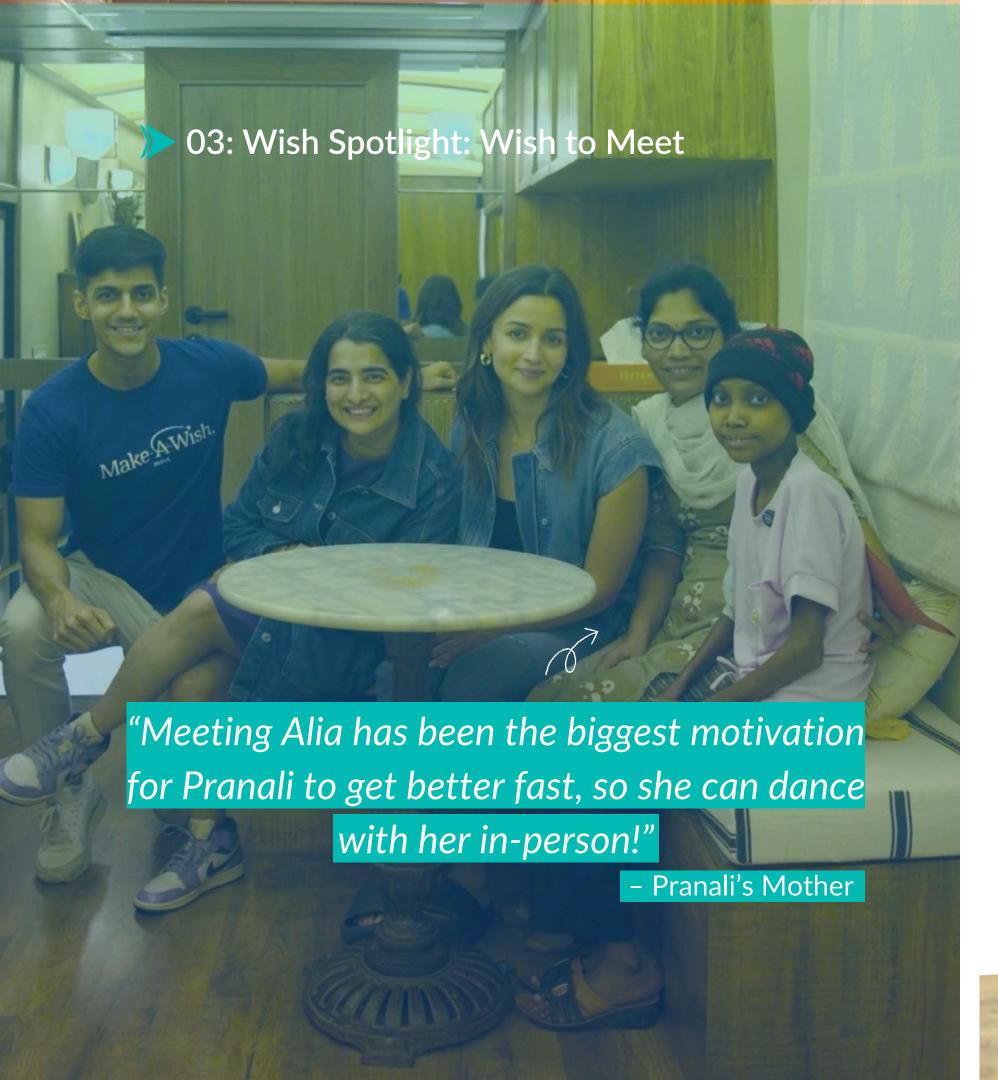
Our aim is to grant the wish of every eligible child.

Since its inception, Make-A-Wish India has granted wishes to 98,000 children bravely battling critical illnesses. But for every child whose wish we've fulfilled, there are many more still waiting. Today, we reach only about 2% of the eligible children in India.

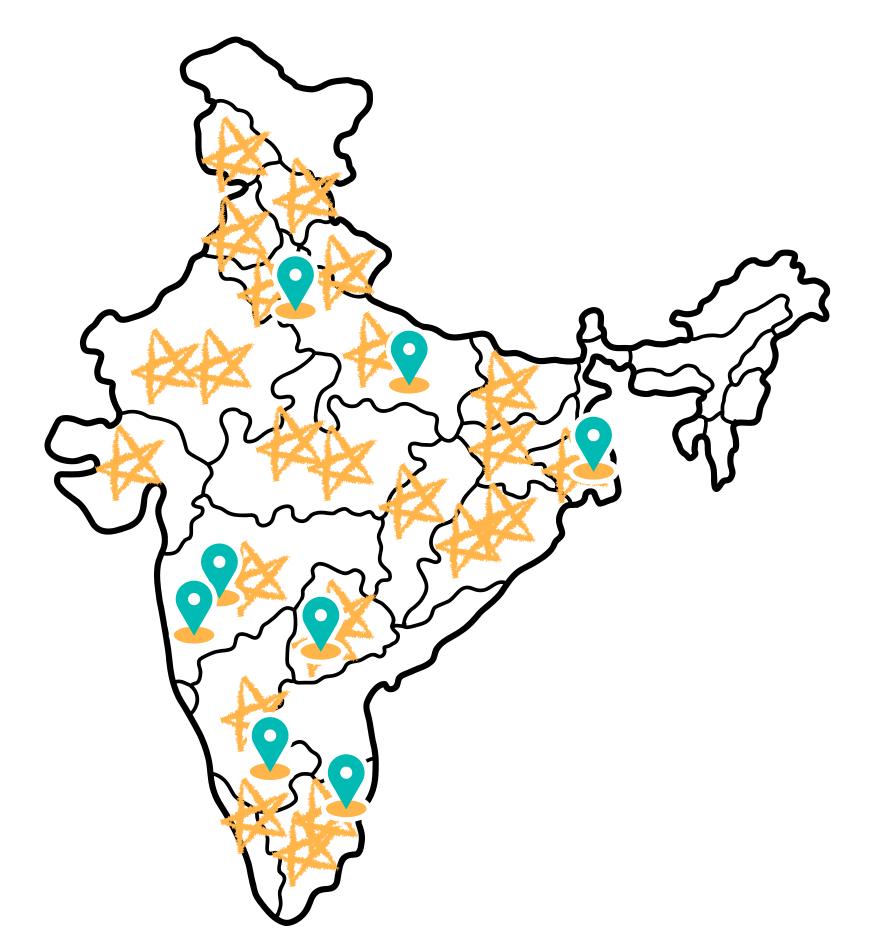






> 04: National Footprint

> 05: Impact Philosophy

Our impact isn't something we only count, it's something we feel. In the glow of a diya our children painted, in their shared laughter, and in the spark that returns when a child rediscovers joy.

Guided by our Global Theory of Change, we focus not on how many wishes we grant, but on how meaningfully we grant them, measuring not just numbers, but joy sparked, hope restored, and families strengthened.

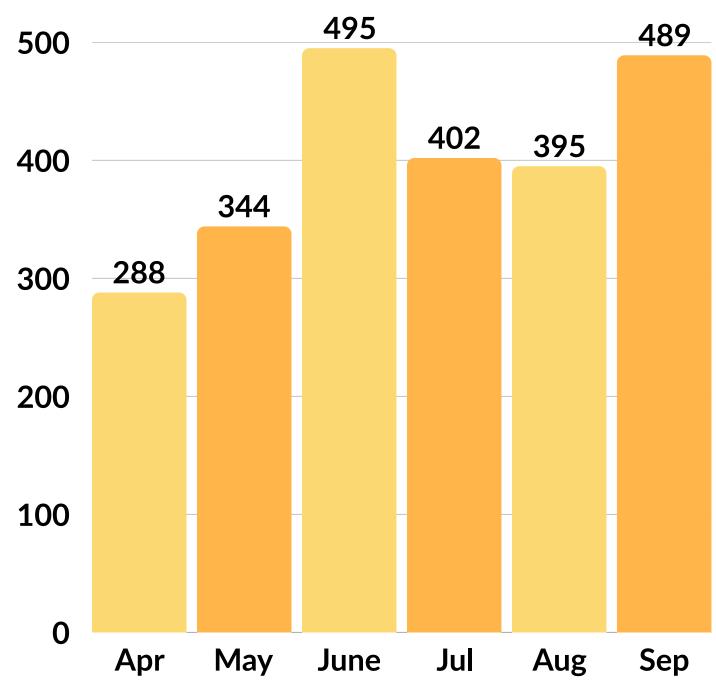


Figure 1: Number of wishes granted april-september.

> 07: Impact Survey | Findings

Six months of data from 507 wish children show what we've always known; a wish is more than a moment of joy. It strengthens families, improves well-being, increases treatment compliance and supports better treatment outcomes.

97%

of wish children felt happy and excited after their wish. 95%

said they love remembering their wish, it still makes them smile.

81%

said their wish helped them forget about being sick. 95%

said their wish made their family happy too.



Survey Overview

Six-month follow-up survey (Apr-Sep 2025) across our eight operational cities in India, adapted from our global Theory of Change to measure joy, resilience, and family well-being.

Data Collection

Conducted in-person by trained volunteers, in preferred languages. Prior consent and comfort ensured for each child.

Sample Scope

507 of 2,413 wish children surveyed, one month post-wish. Randomly selected by volunteers across diverse wish types, ages, and regions.

Analysis & Credibility

Responses verified and analyzed using descriptive stats and themes. At a 95% confidence level, the survey findings carry a ±3.9% margin of error.
